Household Garbage Separation & Disposal Guide

Please follow the separation and disposal rules to help keep the designated garbage stations clean.



- •Please take garbage to your local station on the designated collection day between 5:00 AM and 8:00 AM.
- •Garbage is not collected from Dec. 31 Jan. 3.
- You must use designated garbage bags for garbage that requires them. *You can purchase these bags at your local supermarkets, convenience stores, and on the 2F at city hall.

 - *Some areas may differ from the list. Please check the posted schedule at your local garbage station.



Dispose of any items that are heavily soiled or shredded in burnable garbage.



Remove the cap and label and dispose of them in plastic containers and packaging. You can leave the bottom ring part of the cap that remains on the bottle

Separate paper into 4 categories.



Beverage bottles Seasoning bottles Alcohol bottles

 Empty completely and rinse off any dirty parts with water before disposal.

Lightly rinse it off but do not cut it into small pieces.

Dispose of hard plastic products with miscellaneous

Ensure they are completely emptied out.

 You may crush it to about half its original size, but please retain the overall original shape.

Please refrain from putting out paper garbage on rainy days.

- Only clothing that can be worn as they are can be accepted.
- Dispose of underwear, socks, torn clothing, paper cartons with aluminum foil lining, and heavily soiled items in burnable garbage.

Check the cross-section and separate it from paper boxes and card stock

- Please don't use duct tape.
- Please refrain from putting out cardboard on rainy days
- Dispose of waterproof cardboard and heavily soiled cardboard with burnable garbage in the designated garbage bags.

Non-burnable garbage station






Bags must be see-through to verify the contents. All others are prohibited.

Points to note when disposing

- Completely empty all cans and rinse them with water (ひサイクル) before disposal.
- Empty all spray cans and gas canisters completely
- before disposal. Please do not puncture them. Dispose of empty cans that had paint in them in miscellaneous garbage.

Miscellaneous Garbage

Miscellaneous garbage is primarily disposed of by landfill at the final disposal site.
